

PADI SCUBA Certification is completed in 3 parts; Classroom, Pool Training, and SCUBA Checkout dives.



1. Academic: The first step is to sign up and get your study materials. You may purchase the PADI Manual or PADI eLearning. You will choose classroom option or eLearning option. For the classroom option of your training, you'll watch a three hour DVD and read the Open Water Diver Manual. You may watch the video at home and study at your own pace. After you have studied, we'll schedule a 3 hour classroom session. Our classroom is located at 315 West Main St. Hendersonville. We'll go over everything together and make sure you understand all of the material. There is also a total home study eLearning option. With the PADI eLearning option you will purchase the eLearning from PADI and complete all your academic learning online.

2. Pool: This is the fun part! You will learn and practice your new SCUBA skills. You'll have plenty of time to get comfortable underwater and play with your SCUBA gear. I'll even bring an underwater camera so you may take pictures. We do the pool training in a large indoor heated pool. There are 2 four hour pool sessions included in the price. SCUBA certification is performance based and you may not need both pool sessions.



3. SCUBA Checkout Dives: This is the best part! You will actually go SCUBA diving with your instructor. You'll complete 4 checkout dives over 2 days. During these dives you will demonstrate the skills you learned in the pool. In the summer we dive in Nashville at our own SCUBA quarry. Each day you'll spend about 2 hours in the water. We have SCUBA training dives most every weekend all summer long. In the winter we go to Florida or the Caribbean. You also have the option of a PADI Referral. You may complete your classroom and pool training with us in TN, then complete your 4 checkout dives while on your vacation with any PADI instructor worldwide.

Classroom Option

You will complete your pool training with us then go to our quarry in Nashville for your 4 checkout dives. Local dive quarry entrance fee is \$25 per day. We have pool training most every weekend. Open Water PADI Referral (Complete your checkout dives on your vacation)

Min Age: 10

Includes; Academic and Pool Training with Scuba Nashville.

Complete all your academic and pool training in Nashville and your checkout dives on your vacation. You may take the PADI referral form to any PADI dive shop anywhere in the world to complete your 4 check-out dives. The average cost for your Open Water Checkout dives while on vacation is about \$220.

Classroom Option \$195

+\$35 PADI Manual = \$230 (You will not have to purchase the PADI Manual if you already have one.)

With the classroom option, you will need the PADI Manual and DVD. Watch a three hour DVD and study the Open Water Diver Manual before class. You'll watch the video at home and study at your own pace. After you have studied, we'll schedule a 3 hour classroom session. We'll go over everything together and make sure you understand all of the material. Most classroom sessions are scheduled on a weeknight from 6:00pm to 9:00pm. Once you have completed your classroom you'll need to schedule your pool training. You will receive a PADI Referral form. Our instructor will give you a short quiz to verify you personally completed the eLearning. Once you have completed your eLearning course you'll need to schedule your pool training. Classroom sessions require a minimum of 3 students. Pool training and quarry dives require a minimum of 5 students. Private sessions cost \$100 divided by all attending students. An addition \$25 per student will be added to pool or quarry dives.
